WHEREAS, the Ogdensburg Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient operation of the school district; and

WHEREAS, the Ogdensburg Board of Education established \$15,000 as the maximum travel amount for the current school year and has expended \$6,190.07 as of this date; now
